



The Coastal Training Centre is looking for students who are interested in taking the Introduction to Scaffolding course on **April 24 to May 5, 2017**. The course will be delivered at the Coastal Training Centre located in Prince Rupert. This two-week Introduction to Scaffolding course is the first of three (3) courses that are provided by the “**Construction Maintenance and Allied Workers**” (CMAW).

1. **Introduction to Scaffolding Course** – is for Carpenters or Scaffold Erectors with 0-2499 hours of scaffolding experience.
2. **Intermediate Scaffolding Course** – is for Carpenters or Scaffold Erectors with 2500-4999 hours of scaffolding experience who have successfully completed the Introduction to Scaffolding course.
3. **Scaffolding Qualification Course** – is for Carpenters or Scaffold Erectors with 5000 + hours of experience and who have successfully completed both of the above-mentioned courses.

Prerequisites:

- Minimum Grade 10 completion is required.
- Students must be in good physical condition. The course requires lifting and carrying of scaffold equipment and ladders.

This course is comprised of approximately 25% classroom work and 75% practical time. There will be practical work outdoors almost every day. All students must be prepared to work outdoors.

Upon successful completion of this introductory course, the student will receive a Certificate and plastic wallet card for both the Fall Protection and the Scaffold components of the course.
