

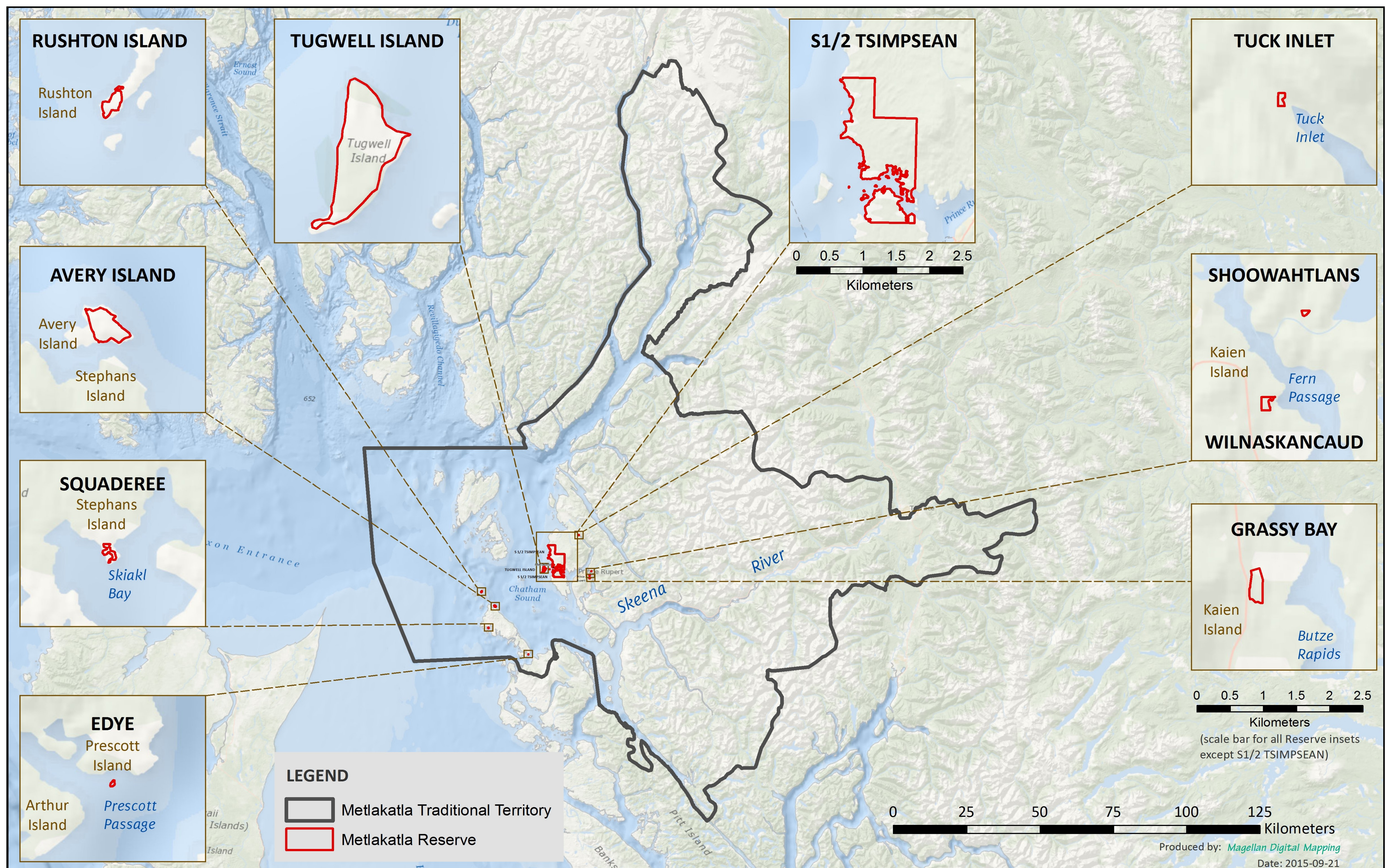


Metlakatla Land Code

What is a Land Code?

The Metlakatla First Nations Land Code will replace the land management sections of the Indian Act. The Land Code is being developed based on the Framework Agreement of First Nations Land Management, which is a government-to-government agreement with Canada that will allow Metlakatla to resume and exercise our own jurisdiction, control and decision making over their Reserve lands and resources. The Metlakatla Land Code is not a treaty and will not affect your Aboriginal Rights.

Laws

The Land Code enables Metlakatla to create and enforce laws to better manage the reserve land and resources.

Environment

Metlakatla First Nation will establish laws and stewardship which protect and manage the environment.

Cultural Heritage Resources

Metlakatla will pass laws to protect Cultural Heritage Resources.

Pathway to Self Governance

The Land Code is an instrument of Self Government.

Metlakatla Governance

The Land Code will strengthen Metlakatla Government by creating a Metlakatla Lands Department.
