TRAFFIC CONTROL PERSON SAFETY

Traffic control people play an important role in road safety by warning motorists about road construction activity in their area and controlling traffic.



Government recognizes the important role which training plays in the safety of traffic control people and road workers at road construction sites.

The ministry requires that all traffic control people are trained to this minimum.

The course is 2 days in length, you will need to have CSA approved boots. No steel toed running shoes allowed. The CSA steel toed boots need to cover ankles. Also clothing for the elements will be needed as there is Practical training required.

There will be Theory and Practical exams Tuition Cost - \$350
