Notice is hereby given that the **Metlakatla First Nation** has called a Nomination Meeting on **July 12, 2023**, in accordance with the *Metlakatla First Nation Election Code (2019)*, for the purpose of eligible Electors nominating candidates for the Office of one (1) Chief and six (6) Councillors, to be elected on **September 29, 2023** for the ensuing term of Office.

#### **Candidacy Eligibility Requirements**

- a) Is the full age of eighteen (18) years on or before the day on which the Election is held;
- b) Is an eligible Voter registered in the Official Voters List;
- c) Has been a member of the Metlakatla First Nation for a period of not less than twelve (12) months immediately preceding the day on which the Election is held;
- d) Is ordinarily a resident of the Metlakatla Traditional Territory and has resided on the Traditional Territory for a continuous period of six months immediately preceding the Nomination Meeting;
- e) Is <u>not</u> the subject of an application for bankruptcy that is yet to be discharged;
- f) Has not been convicted of a Criminal Offence;
- g) Is nominated to be a Candidate and the nomination must be seconded pursuant to the provisions of the Code; and
  - i. Be present at the meeting and accept their nomination verbally; or
  - ii. Give written authorization to the nominator to let their name stand; or
  - iii. Give their written and signed authorization to the Electoral Officer prior to the close of the Nomination Meeting to let their name stand.

**Please note** that a Candidate may run for either Chief Councillor or Councillor, but not both.

Individual voters may nominate or second a maximum of 3 candidates, 1 off-reserve, 1 on-reserve, 1 Chief. The composition of council is one Chief Councillor, 3 On-Reserve Councillors, and 3 Off-Reserve Councillors.

#### Pre-Nomination Meeting Candidate Requirements (no later than July 5th)

- a) Written Declaration of Eligibility (Appendix E)
- b) Complete Criminal Record search report (not more than 6 months old)
- c) Required Affidavit/Declaration (Section 6.7c of the Code)

#### Post-Nomination Meeting Candidate Requirements (no later than 4:00PM on July 14th)

- a) A **non-refundable deposit** of one hundred dollars (\$100.00); and
- b) A completed and signed Acceptance of Candidacy form (Appendix J)

#### **Mail-In Nominations**

Any Voter may nominate or second a maximum of three (3) Candidates in writing prior to the start of the Nomination Meeting by completing and submitting a Written Nomination Form. All nominations will be recorded if delivered to the Electoral Officer by July 11<sup>th</sup> 2023.
