Metlakatla First Nation has an immediate opening for two full-time General Labourers in Metlakatla, British Columbia. The position typically entails assisting with site preparation, maintenance and clean-up. The successful candidate should be able to follow instructions, wear steel-toe boots and other industry-specified Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) at all times, complete work assigned by the required deadline, be physically fit, demonstrate wellness, and be able to lift up to 50 pounds.

#### The Candidate:

- Perform various tasks, including landscaping, weeding, raking, garbage collection, brush clearing, sweeping, and clean-up.
- Maintain the tools on the job site, using and storing them properly and securely at the end of every day.
- Operate basic hand tools such as shovels, rakes etc.
- Operate basic power tools such as brush cutters, chain saws, electric drills, etc.
- Provide manual labour on various tasks and assignments.
- Must be physically able to complete a variety of General Labourer tasks.
- Must be able to tolerate dusty and noisy work environments.
- Be able to identify hazards onsite and work in and implement safe work practices and contribute to a safe work environment.
- Must have a strong work ethic and be able to commit to the work schedule.
- Perform all other tasks within the scope of the position and as assigned.

#### Qualifications, Skills and Abilities:

- High School Diploma or GED required.
- Must have Class 5 and SVOP certificate
- A positive attitude in the workplace is required, as is the ability to adhere to all Human Resources, Operational and Health & Safety policies and procedures.
- Self-motivated and able to work safely and independently without constant supervision.
- Must be able to bend, stretch, twist, or reach with body, arms and/or legs.
- Care about the quality of work.
- Can work well on a team and follow safety standards.
- Experience using (or ability to learn) power equipment.
- Able to work inside and outside in year-round weather conditions.
- In good physical condition, able to lift and carry up to 50 lbs., sit and stand for extended periods, kneel, climb ladders, and walk on varied terrain.
- Ability to work different extended hours and holidays as required.
